## First Words

The Keydets continue a six-game homestand Friday when they take on the Buccaneers of East Tennessee State. It will be the first meeting between VMI and ETSU since 2003, and the Bucs hold a 44-39 edge in the all-time series.

Infielder Thomas Stallings homered in April 7's loss to Radford, his fourth home run over the past three games. In a startling stat, Stallings had hit four home runs in his previous 133 career games.

One game after moving into the top-10 in program history in walks (see page three), Jordan Tarsovich tied B.T. Good '06 and Donny White '65 for fourth on the all-time Keydet steals listing with his 56th career theft. Tarsovich stole the bag April 7 against Radford.

VMI is looking to get over .500 in conference play for the first time since losing at Winthrop April 25 of last season to fall to 9-10 in the league.

## KEYDETS LOOK TO TURN THINGS AROUND AT HOME:

After losing 6-2 to Radford on April 7, the Keydets are just 2-9 at home on the year. Contrast that with the team's record away from home, a much more palatable 7-8, and the Keydets will be looking to turn things around at Gray-Minor Stadium this weekend.

## STALLINGS GOES DEEP AGAIN:

## TARSOVICH TIES FOR FOURTH:

## STALLINGS NAMED NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

VMI infielder Thomas Stallings was named a Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week on April 6. Stallings went 7-for-15 with 3 homers, 5 runs scored, 5 RBI and 16 total bases over four games. Prior to a doubleheader at Furman, he entered the day hitting only .213. He then went 7-for-10 with 3 home runs and 5 RBI. Two of his home runs came in back-to-back at-bats as he became the first Keydet to accomplish the feat since 2010.

Stallings is the third Keydet to earn Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week honors, joining Jordan Ballard (2010) and Reed Garrett (2014).

## HOME RUN NOTES FROM FURMAN:

The Keydets hit 10 home runs in April 4's doubleheader sweep of Furman - six of them in game 2. Below are notes about the six home run game.

Thomas Stallings was the only player to hit multiple homers in the game - he hit two in back to back at-bats, becoming the first Keydet to do so since 2010 (Cory Spangenberg).

The six homers were the most the Keydets had hit since a school-record seven on April 10, 2009 against Gardner-Webb.

Tyler Tharp hit his first career home run in the game.

Brandon Angus, Will Connerley and Stallings went back to back to back in the third inning. It was the first time since 2013 that the Keydets had hit consecutive home runs in a game.

## THARP HITS FIRST CAREER HOMER:

One of the 10 home runs the Keydets hit on April 4 was hit by first baseman/DH Tyler Tharp - it was the first career long ball for the sophomore. Tharp is the sec-

## WOODS AND LOPEZ RETURN:

The injured Keydets have finally begun to return - after Brandon Angus returned to action March 24, Andrew Woods and Ray Lopez both saw their first action in at least two weeks during the April 3-4 Furman series.

## DOUBLEHEADER SWEEP

**NOTABLE:** VMI's doubleheader sweep of

Furman marked the first time the Keydets had swept a twinbill from a conference foe since April of 2010 (UNC Asheville).

**TARSOVICH PASSES TWO:** By drawing three walks in the series finale against Furman (4/4), Jordan Tarsovich passed two players - including VMI Hall of Famer David Groseclose '95 - and moved up to ninth on the all-time walks list in VMI history.

**BACK TO BACK CLOSE GAMES:** VMI played back to back one-run games March 31 and April 1 against Virginia Tech and UVA - It marked the second time this season that the Keydets had played back to back one run contests (March 21-22). 11 of VMI's 25 games have been decided by two runs or less.

**NOTABLE STAT ON STAATS:** Kyle Staats took the loss March 31 at Virginia Tech and picked up the win in VMI's victory the next day at UVA. He is the first Keydet pitcher to get opposite decisions in back to back games since Matt Edwards in April of 2009.

**THREE STRAIGHT GAMES:** With his home run in the April 1 win over UVA, Jordan Tarsovich homered in his third straight contest. He became the first Keydet since April 2012 to accomplish that feat.

**BACK TO BACK WINS OVER UVA:** VMI's April 1 win over #12 Virginia in Charlottesville marked the first time since 1958 and 1960 that the Keydets had won back to back games over the Cavaliers.

**BARBERY WINS THIRD:** Freshman LHP Brandon Barbery earned his third win of the year March 28 against Samford. He became the first Keydet true freshman since Campbell Henkel in 2011 to have three victories.

His next target is John Garrett's six-win freshman season, set in 2010, a figure that is tied for seventh in school history.

**CONNERLEY HOMERS AGAIN:** Will Connerley hit his fourth home run of the year during the end of March Samford series, equaling the most any Keydet hit all of last season. Only one Keydet had more during the past two years, when offense was reduced in college baseball, then that four number - Rob Dickinson (7) during his 2013 Big South Player of the Year season.

**ANGUS RETURNS, OTHERS REMAIN SIDELINED:** Outfielder Brandon Angus returned to the starting lineup on March 26 after missing the past six-plus weeks with a broken right hand. Ray Lopez (shoulder) and Andrew Woods (thumb) remain on the shelf:

## **SPRING BREAK ENDS WITH WIN, FIRST SOCON VICTORY SINCE '03:**

The Keydets downed Wofford 2-1 on March 22, ending a seven-game losing streak and getting their first SoCon win of the year. It was their first victory in the league since May 17, 2003 at The Citadel.

## **YOUTH IN WEEKEND ROTATION:**

After the injury to Andrew Woods, true freshman Jared Silva moved into the starting rotation, giving the Keydets one of the youngest weekend rotations in the country. Silva, Austin Heenan and Brandon Barbery had made a combined five career starts heading into last weekend's series at Wofford.

**EAGLE STARTS TO FLY:** True freshman Matt Eagle made the first appearances of his career on the spring break trip this past week. Eagle pitched 4 2/3 innings at ODU on March 17, allowing just two baserunners and striking out five in his collegiate debut in his hometown. He then took a hard-luck loss at Wofford on 3/21, giving up an unearned run in the eighth inning.

## **WINN NAMED TO WATCH LIST:**

VMI catcher Matt Winn was named to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List on March 11. Winn was one of 75 catchers tabbed to the first round for the honor given to the top catcher in Division I, and it marks the third consecutive year he has been on the initial listing. In 2013, Winn was one of 15 semifinalists for the honor.

## **SUCCESS AT JMU CONTINUES:**

The Keydets downed James Madison 7-3 March 11 in Harrisonburg. It was the second time in the last three trips to JMU that VMI had emerged victorious after not having won there previously since 1976.

**A PAIR OF FIRSTS:** There were two notable firsts accomplished for Keydet players in March 11's win at JMU. Will Malbon hit his first career home run, and Jared Silva picked up his first collegiate victory.

## **LONG BALLS FOR CONNERLEY:**

Outfielder Will Connerley, in the lineup in part due to an injury to Brandon Angus, hit two home runs in the series against Binghamton March 8-9. That was the first time a VMI player had hit two home runs in the same series since April 20-21 of 2012, when Jacob Morley and Rob Dickinson both hit multiple home runs in a series against Campbell.

## **THARP AND LOPEZ HIT WELL AGAINST BINGHAMTON:**

First baseman Tyler Tharp and outfielder Ray Lopez each hit .500 in the series against Binghamton.

For Lopez, the effort actually lowered his season average to .550.

**LATE HOME OPENER:** The March 8 home opener was the third latest for the Keydets since VMI began playing baseball in the month of February (1988). The Keydets opened at home later than March 8 twice during that time - 1989 (March 19) and 2000 (March 17).

## **WEATHER REEKS HAVOC:**

The Keydets had nine games cancelled between Feb. 16 and March 8, the longest time period between baseball games in VMI baseball history. That figure does not account for two games that were postponed twice, Feb. 17-25 against William and Mary and March 3/4 at UVA. The UVA game will be made up April 1 in Charlottesville, but the William and Mary game has yet to be announced.

**BARBERY WINS DEBUT:** Freshman Brandon Barbery won his collegiate debut on Feb. 15, pitching six shutout innings at North Florida. Barbery was the first Keydet freshman to win a game on opening weekend since at least 2000, when game by game records are precise.

## **LOPEZ AND MALBON EXPLODE OFFENSIVELY:**

On opening weekend, both Ray Lopez and Will Malbon had huge performances. Malbon hit .333 with a trio of extra-base hits, a total that matched his 2014 season output, and Lopez went 5 for 5 in the middle game of the North Florida series. That was VMI's first five-hit game since 2011.

**HADRA MAKES HISTORY:** When VMI won its season opener on Feb. 13 at North Florida, it made history for new head coach Jonathan Hadra. Hadra became the first Keydet head coach to beat a Division I team in his debut game since Donny White in 1974, and the first to beat any team in his debut since Paul Maini in 1988.

**A NEW COACH:** Not only is a new season dawning for the Keydets with the 2015 campaign, but it's a new era as well, the Jonathan Hadra era.

Hadra is the 20th coach in the modern era of VMI baseball, and replaced longtime head man Marlin Ikenberry this past November.

## **ANGUS AND WOODS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-SOCON:**

VMI players Andrew Woods and Brandon Angus were named to the Preseason All-SoCon Second Team, according to information released by the league Thursday morning, Feb. 5.

Woods went 5-2 with a 2.70 ERA last

year, limiting opponents to a .261 batting average against, and then spent the summer pitching for the Yakima Valley Pippins in the West Coast League, where he led the circuit in strikeouts. He is VMI's expected Friday starter, while Angus will start in the outfield after hitting .333 with 29 stolen bases last year, the fifth-highest single season theft total in VMI history. Angus earned Second Team All-Big South honors for that performance.
