First Words

This series, and The Citadel/Wofford series as well, will decide the #7, #8 and #9 seeds for next week's Southern Conference Tournament. See page two for tournament scenarios.

Individually, all eyes will be on Tyler Tharp and Josh Winder as they look to set single season records in these three games. Tharp's season is among VMI's best all-time in home runs, total bases, slugging percentage and hits, while Winder will be looking to set new VMI marks in innings pitched and strikeouts. In fact, Winder could become the first Keydet pitcher ever to surpass the 100-innings pitched plateau.

The Keydets will be looking to turn around recent ill fortune against the Bucs, as ETSU has captured 12 of the last 15 meetings between the programs dating back to the year 2000. Since both programs rejoined the SoCon, ETSU has won five of six.

Thursday's game will bid two of the top five starters - in terms of innings pitched - in the SoCon this season, Winder (95.2) and Ryan Simpler (86.2).

WHAT THIS SERIES MEANS: The three-game series between ETSU and VMI holds a great deal of significance for next week's Southern Conference Tournament. Below are brief comments.

If VMI sweeps ETSU...

VMI would move to 10-14 and clinch at least the #7 seed in the main draw.
Samford would need one win vs. UNCG to clinch the #6 seed, which would lock VMI into the #7 seed.

ETSU and The Citadel would play in Tuesday's #8 - #9 single-elimination first round game.

If VMI wins two of three vs. ETSU...

VMI would move to 9-15.

Samford could finish no worse than sixth.
ETSU would be locked into the #8-#9 game.
The Citadel would need to sweep Wofford, otherwise, VMI would be the #7 seed and The Citadel would play ETSU Tuesday.

If ETSU wins two of three at VMI...

VMI and ETSU would finish tied at 8-16, ETSU would hold the tiebreaker.
VMI would be locked into the first round #8-#9 game Tuesday, and would play The Citadel unless the Bulldogs win two of three against Wofford. In that case, VMI would play ETSU.

If ETSU sweeps VMI...

VMI would be 7-17, ETSU would be 9-15.
VMI would be locked into the #8-#9 game Tuesday.
The Citadel would need a sweep vs. Wofford to earn the #7 seed, otherwise, the first round game would be The Citadel vs. VMI. If The Citadel does sweep in this scenario, numerous other considerations (including Samford's results, etc) come into play to determine VMI's opponent.

most in any year other than 2010, when Cory Spangenberg had 140 and Jordan Ballard and Graham Sullivan had 134 apiece.

HITS - Tharp currently has 67 hits, five shy of tying Kelly Sweppenhiser's 72 hits in 2006 for the 10th-most in school history. If Tharp breaks into the top-10 in that stat, he'd be only the second player since 2011 to do so.

HOME RUNS - And finally, Tharp has 16 home runs, tying Greg Weddle's 16 bombs in 1985 for the second-most in VMI history. The school record is Ballard's 18 in 2010.

WINDER'S RECORD CHASES: In addition to Tharp, Keydet ace Josh Winder is also in pursuit of single-season marks.

Strikeouts - Winder enters Thursday's start with 105 K's on the season and is just the third Keydet to ever hit the 100 K mark in a year. He is two away from sole possession of second place and, with six strikeouts Thursday, would surpass Michael Bowman's 110 strikeout effort in 2007 and set a new school record.

Innings Pitched - Winder enters the series with 95 innings pitched. He is just the eighth pitcher in Keydet history to exceed 90 innings pitched in a season. The school record is 99 IP, set by the aforementioned Bowman in 2007.

LONGEST GAME EVER: The Keydets played their longest game ever Sunday, a 5 hour, 14 minute epic with Furman. It was the first game over five hours in Keydet baseball history, as the previous longest game was a 4:45 affair April 13, 2014 at High Point.

THARP'S RECORD CHASES: Right fielder Tyler Tharp is chasing several single-season marks over the course of VMI's final games of the season.

SLUGGING PERCENTAGE - Tharp enters this series with what would be the sixth-highest single-season slugging percentage in school history at .682. He would be the first player since 2007 to join the top-10 list in that stat, and just the second since 1999.

TOTAL BASES - Tharp enters the ETSU series with 131 total bases. That is the fourth-most in school history - and
