**Games 5 & 6 - VMI at #10 Kentucky (11/18), VMI vs. Kentucky Christian (11/20)**

## Keydets Take on Kentucky Sunday in Rupp Arena

*Return Home to Face Kentucky Christian Tuesday*

VMI basketball plays its second road game of the year against national power Kentucky Sunday night at Rupp Arena almost ten years to the day after shocking the Wildcats 111-103 in the 2008-09 season opener at Rupp Arena. On Tuesday, the Keydets return to Cameron Hall and take their 3-0 home mark against Kentucky Christian in the first meeting between the two teams.

### Last Time Out: VMI 78, USC Upstate 72 (Wed., Nov. 14)

Freshman center Jake Stephens scored a career-high 20 points and the Keydets iced the game from the free-throw line Wednesday night as the VMI men's basketball team defeated USC-Upstate 78-72 in non-conference play. Stephens had 12 first-half points as the teams were tied at 31 entering the second half. VMI led 68-64 with less than 1:30 remaining on the game clock when junior Garrett Gilkeson drilled a three-pointer to put the Keydets up seven. The Spartans were forced to foul in the game's final minute, and VMI responded by making 7-of-8 from the free-throw line to seal the win. Sophomore guard Bubba Parham sank all four of his attempts down the stretch, scoring 12 of his 14 points in the second half to go with a game-high seven assists.

Stephens was nearly perfect from the floor, hitting all four of his three-point attempts and 6-of-7 overall in just 20 minutes. Greg Parham posted 12 points, and Myles Lewis had eight points and a game-best eight rebounds. Tyler Creammer added eight points and six rebounds and Sarju Patel nailed 3-of-4 three point attempts and finished with 11 points.

### Last Meeting with Kentucky: Nov. 14, 2008

Behind a career-best 30-point performance by senior guard Travis Holmes, VMI scored its first win over an SEC program in 32 years, stunning Kentucky, 111-103 in front of 22,579 fans at Rupp Arena. The Keydets matched a facility record with 14 three-pointers, including five by sophomore gunner Austin Kenon, now a VMI assistant coach. Kentucky got a valiant effort from junior Jodie Meeks, who poured in a career-best 39 points in leading a massive second-half comeback. Down the stretch, VMI had solid free-throw shooting throughout the contest, ending the evening with a 77% clip from the line. The Keydets shot 45% from beyond the arc, including 53% in the first half, and 49% from the floor for the game. The Keydets had six players in double figures for the night, with Travis Holmes and Gabriel leading the way. Senior Willie Bell had 12 points and eight rebounds in the win, while senior Chavis Holmes contributed 16 points, two rebounds and six assists.

### A Win over Kentucky would ...

Give VMI its first win over an SEC program since the November 2008 upset over Kentucky in Rupp Arena and only the second since the 1975-76 season.

### SERIES HISTORY – VMI vs. Kentucky

This will be the ninth meeting between the schools that first met in 1914. Kentucky leads the series 5-3. VMI will be making its third appearance overall at Rupp Arena with the two prior appearances in 2001-02 and 2008-09. The teams also met in the 1977 NCAA East Regional at College Park, Maryland in the Sweet 16 with Kentucky prevailing, 93-78.

### DID YOU KNOW?

That VMI and Kentucky's basketball programs share a head coach? Alpha Brumage guided VMI basketball for two seasons from 1911-1913 before serving as Kentucky head coach for two years in 1914 and 1915.

### A FULL SLATE IN NOVEMBER

VMI will jump right into action in the opening month of the season with eight contests including five home games and three road games. The November month includes a stretch of six games over 13 days including contests at Kentucky and Pitt. Last season, VMI played just six November games with two at Cameron Hall.

### PERFECT AT HOME

The 78-72 win over USC Upstate Tuesday night moved VMI to 3-0 at home for the first time since the 2015-16 season.

### STEPHENS ANOTHER CAREER NIGHT

His career is just four games long, but freshman forward/center Jake Stephens continues to make a big splash. The Bunker Hill, W.Va. native poured in a career-high 20 points on 6 of 7 floor shooting and 4 of 4 in three-pointers to help lead VMI to a 78-72 win over USC Upstate at Cameron Hall. Stephens has averaged 17.0 PPG his last two games and has shot 61% from the floor (11 for 18).

### JOIN THE SCORING PARTY

VMI placed six players in double figures in the 98-34 win over Goucher Sunday at Cameron Hall. It was the first time VMI had placed six with 10+ points in a game since February 27, 2016 when VMI outscored The Citadel 111-95.

### HIGH OCTANE

The 98 points scored by VMI against Goucher Nov. 11 was the most since February 11, 2017 when VMI tallied a 101-78 win over The Citadel in Lexington.

### KEYDETS SHARP AT LINE

Through games of Nov. 14, VMI is ranked first in the SoCon in free throw shooting with a 78.3% team mark (65 of 83). VMI is also second in the league in steals with 9.8 per game.

### LET IT RAIN

VMI's 15 3-pointers made against Goucher Nov. 11 was the most treys logged by the Keydets in a game since 20 were drained in a 113-111 win at Western Carolina on February 21, 2015. The Keydets followed with 10 more treys in the win over Upstate Nov. 14.

### NEW FACES JOIN STAFF

Two new faces joined the VMI coaching and support staff in 2018-19 with Steve Enright being named assistant basketball coach in June and Tom Kiely becoming Director of Basketball Operations in September.

Enright came to VMI from nearby Bridgewater (Va.) College where he served three years on the Eagles coaching staff and was promoted to associate head coach before the
