Keydets Travel to Take on Stetson During Thanksgiving Break

VMI basketball plays its third road game of the year Friday afternoon against the Stetson Hatters of the Atlantic Sun in what will be VMI's final road game in the month of November. It will also be VMI's longest road trip of the season distance wise with DeLand, Florida approximately 730 miles from Lexington, Virginia.

Last Time Out: VMI 106, Kentucky Christian 80 (Tue., Nov. 20)

Sophomore guard Bubba Parham scored 33 points Tuesday evening to lead the VMI men's basketball team to a 106-80 victory over visiting Kentucky Christian University in a non-conference contest. Parham was just two points short of his career-high 35 points, set Sunday against the University of Kentucky, ranked #10 in NCAA Division 1. He has 68 points and 15 three-pointers in his last two games and has 10 career games with 20 points or more. Against Kentucky Christian, Parham had 20 first-half points to give the Keydets a 58-39 halftime edge. The Knights cut the lead to 78-65 with 10:37 remaining on the game clock, but a quick 10-2 VMI run put the game out of reach. Garrett Gilkeson had one of two Keydet double doubles with 15 points, shooting 5-of-6 from the floor and 3-of-4 from the three-point line, with 10 rebounds. Tyler Creammer contributed 12 points and a career-high 14 boards, while Myles Lewis scored 13. Greg Parham tallied 11 points and five assists and Sarju Patel came off the bench to add 10 points as six Keydets reached double figures. Juran Ligonde scored a team-high 23 points for Kentucky Christian.

Last Meeting with Stetson: December 29, 1978

Playing in the consolation game of the Tangerine Bowl Tournament, VMI fell to Stetson 98-89 on December 29, 1978 in a contest played at Rollins College Field House. The Keydets trailed 50-37 at the break and could not close the gap despite 22 points from forward Geoff Hinshelwood and 21 points from forward John Goode. Stetson shot 55.2% from the floor and was by guard Kevin Tucker who hit 8 of 11 shots from the floor and scored 22 points. The Hatters also drained 24 of 29 free throws and forced 26 VMI turnovers in the game.

SERIES HISTORY – VMI vs. Stetson

This will be only the third meeting between VMI and Stetson in basketball with the Hatters prevailing in the two prior matchups, 62-61 on December 29, 1969 and 98-89 on the same date in 1978.

A FULL SLATE IN NOVEMBER

The Keydets will be wrapping up a busy month of November that saw eight contests including five home games and three road games. The November month included a stretch of six games over 15 days including contests at Kentucky and Pitt. Last season, VMI played just six November games with two at Cameron Hall.

PERFECT AT HOME

The 106-80 win over Kentucky Christian Tuesday night moved VMI to 4-0 at Cameron Hall for the first time since 2015-16.

A RECORD WEEK FOR BUBBA

VMI sophomore guard Bubba Parham scored a career-high 35 points and knocked down a school record 10 3-pointers in the 92-82 loss at #10 ranked Kentucky Nov. 18. It was the first time Parham had surpassed the 30+ point plateau in a game in his career and he followed it up two nights later with 33 points against Kentucky Christian at Cameron Hall. Parham, the 2018 SoCon Freshman of the Year as selected by the media, has 10 games of 20+ points in his career.

BOMBS AWAY

The Keydets have hit double digits in 3-pointers made in four consecutive games with 56 treys over that stretch. VMI hit 19 threes at Kentucky Nov. 18 which was the most an opponent had ever made against UK in its long and storied basketball history. VMI also has hit 15 threes against Goucher Nov. 11, 10 vs. USC Upstate Nov. 14, and 12 vs. Kentucky Christian Nov. 20. The last time VMI drained 20+ treys in a contest was in a 113-111 win at Western Carolina on February 21, 2015. Through games of November 20, VMI is second in the SoCon with 11.7 3-pointers made per game.

JOIN THE SCORING PARTY

VMI placed six players in double figures for the second time this season in the 106-80 win over Kentucky Christian Tuesday night at Cameron Hall. Previously, the Keydets had six reach double figures scoring in the 98-34 win over Goucher Nov. 11 at Cameron Hall. It had been the first time VMI had placed six with 10+ points in a game since February 27, 2016 when VMI outscored The Citadel 111-95.

HIGH OCTANE

The 106 points scored by the Keydets Tuesday night vs. Kentucky Christian was first time VMI had hit the century mark in scoring in a game since February 11, 2017 when VMI dispatched The Citadel 101-78.

KEYDETS SHARP AT LINE

Through games of Nov. 20, VMI is ranked first in the SoCon in free throw shooting with a 78.2% team mark (86 of 110).

GILKESON ON A HIGH

He was known as a dependable defender and rebounder heading into the season, but junior guard Garrett Gilkeson has stepped up his scoring as well and is averaging 11.5 points and shooting 50% from 3-points range (11-20). Gilkeson also tied his career-high with 10 rebounds against Kentucky Christian and added 15 points for his second career double-double.

STEADY GREG

VMI sophomore guard Greg Parham has scored in double figures in all six games and is tied for second with Garrett Gilkeson in team scoring with 11.5 PPG. Parham is the only Keydet besides Bubba Parham to tally in double figures in all six games played.

CREAMMER DOUBLES UP

Fresh off a career-high 13 points scoring at Kentucky Nov. 18, junior forward/center Tyler Creammer posted his third career double-double with 12 points and 14 rebounds against Kentucky Christian Nov. 20.

STEPHENS ANOTHER CAREER NIGHT

His career was just four games long, but freshman forward center Jake Stephens made a big splash on November 14. The Bunker Hill, W.Va. native poured in a career-high 20 points on 6 of 7 floor shooting and 4 of 4 in three-pointers to help lead VMI to a 78-72 win over USC Upstate at Cameron Hall.

NEW FACES JOIN STAFF

Two new faces joined the VMI coaching and support staff in 2018-19 with Steve Enright being named assistant basketball coach in June and Tom Kiely becoming Director of Basketball Operations in September.

Enright came to VMI from nearby Bridgewater (Va.) College where he served three years on the Eagles coaching staff and was promoted to associate head coach before the 2016-17 season. Enright previously served on head coach Dan Hurley's staff at Rhode Island where he was the Rams' assistant director of basketball operations. He also coached
