Keydets Close out November at Home against American

VMI basketball closes out its Month of November with a home game against American Tuesday night at Cameron Hall. The Keydets (5-2) take a two-game win streak into the contest and look to turn the tables after a 69-64 loss at American last year.

Last Time Out: VMI 87, Stetson 79 (OT) (Fri., Nov. 23)

A Tyler Creammer rebound and putback to force overtime proved to be the impetus to propel VMI to victory as the Keydets would go on to defeat the host Stetson Hatters by an 87-79 score in overtime Friday afternoon at the Edmunds Center in DeLand, Florida. With the Keydets (5-2) down by three, VMI sophomore Bubba Parham was intentionally fouled with just over two seconds left in regulation to go to the free throw line. He made the first then purposefully clanked the ball off the rim on the second hoping for a VMI offensive rebound and quick putback. Creammer came through in the clutch to grab the board and lay it up to knot the score at 69 apiece just before the buzzer to force extra time. In OT, sophomores Greg Parham and Sarju Patel converted clutch three-pointers to rally the Keydets midway through the overtime before Myles Lewis scored a pair of free throws and breakout steal and dunk to propel VMI to the win. The Keydets totaled 18 points in the extra time while holding the Hatters to just 10. Bubba Parham logged his third consecutive game with 30+ points as he finished with 30.

Last Meeting with American: Nov. 25, 2017

Guard Larry Motuzis scored 26 points including 21 in the second half to lead American University past VMI, 69-64, November 25 at Bender Arena. VMI sophomore forward Tyler Creammer recorded his first career-double double with 16 points and a career-high 11 rebounds. Freshman guard Greg Parham scored a career-high 12 points which included two three-point shots. American sophomore guard Sa'eed Nelson contributed 21 points for the Eagles hitting eight of 16 shots from the floor and guard CB Diallo chipped in 10 points.

-Be VMI's first over American in the series.

-Move VMI to 5-0 at home for the first time since 2013-14 and be the best overall start since 2010-11 (6-1).

SERIES HISTORY – VMI vs. American

This will be only the second meeting between VMI and American with the Eagles claiming a 69-64 win at Bender Arena in Washington, D.C. last year.

A FULL SLATE IN NOVEMBER

The Keydets will be wrapping up a busy month of November that saw eight contests including five home games and three road games. The November month included a stretch of six games over 15 days including contests at Kentucky and Pitt. Last season, VMI played just six November games with two at Cameron Hall.

PERFECT AT HOME

The 106-80 win over Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 moved VMI to 4-0 at Cameron Hall for the first time since 2015-16. The Keydets have not been 5-0 at home since the 2013-14 season. The 5-2 overall start is VMI's best since 2010-11 when the Keydets started 6-1 on the year.

ROAD AND OVERTIME LOG

With an 86-79 overtime win at Stetson Nov. 23, VMI ended a two-game skid in extra play and won its first overtime game since February 21, 2015 when the Keydets prevailed 113-111 in 2OT at Western Carolina. The Stetson win was also VMI's first road win of the year and first since a 75-71 win at The Citadel on February 17, 2018.

BUBBA CONTINUES TO ROLL

With three straight 30+ point games, VMI sophomore guard Bubba Parham has vaulted to the top of the SoCon in scoring with a 24.3 average. Never a one-dimensional performer, Parham also garnered a career-high nine rebounds in VMI's win 87-79 OT win at Stetson. The Snellville, Ga. Native started his torrid three-game stretch when he scored a career-high 35 points and knocked down a school record 10 3-pointers in the 92-82 loss at #10 ranked Kentucky Nov. 18. It was the first time Parham had surpassed the 30+ point plateau in a game in his career and he followed it up two nights later with 33 points against Kentucky Christian at Cameron Hall. Parham, the 2018 SoCon Freshman of the Year as selected by the media, has 11 games of 20+ points in his career.

LEWIS - A CAREER DAY

Sophomore forward Myles Lewis played a key role in VMI's win at Stetson with a career-high 15 points and career-high nine rebounds. Lewis also set a new career mark in assists with three vs. the Hatters.

BOMBS AWAY

The Keydets have hit double digits in 3-pointers made in five consecutive games with 68 treys over that stretch. VMI hit 19 threes at Kentucky Nov. 18 which was the most an opponent had ever made against UK in its long and storied basketball history. VMI also hit 15 threes against Goucher Nov. 11, 10 vs. USC Upstate Nov. 14, 12 vs. Kentucky Christian Nov. 20, and 12 at Stetson Nov. 23. The last time VMI drained 20+ treys in a contest was in a 113-111 win at Western Carolina on February 21, 2015. Through games of November 25, VMI is second in the SoCon with 11.7 3-pointers made per game and second in 3 FG percentage (.398).

JOIN THE SCORING PARTY

VMI placed six players in double figures for the second time this season in the 106-80 win over Kentucky Christian on Nov. 20 at Cameron Hall. Previously, the Keydets had six reach double figures scoring in the 98-34 win over Goucher Nov. 11 at Cameron Hall. It had been the first time VMI had placed six with 10+ points in a game since February 27, 2016 when VMI outscored The Citadel 111-95.

HIGH OCTANE

The 106 points scored by the Keydets Nov. 20 vs. Kentucky Christian was first time VMI had hit the century mark in scoring in a game since February 11, 2017 when VMI dispatched The Citadel 101-78.

KEYDETS SHARP AT LINE

Through games of Nov. 25, VMI is ranked first in the SoCon in free throw shooting with a 75.9% team mark (101-133).

GILKESON ON A HIGH

He was known as a dependable defender and rebounder heading into the season, but junior guard Garrett Gilkeson has stepped up his scoring as well and is averaging 11.1 points and shooting 50% from 3-points range (12-24). Gilkeson also tied his career-high with 10 rebounds against Kentucky Christian and added 15 points for his second career double-double.

STEADY GREG

VMI sophomore guard Greg Parham has scored in double figures in all seven games and is in team scoring with 11.7 PPG. Parham is the only Keydet besides Bubba Parham to tally in double figures in all seven games played.

CREAMMER DOUBLES UP

Fresh off a career-high 13 points scoring at Kentucky Nov. 18, junior forward/center Tyler Creammer posted his third career double-double with 12 points and 14 rebounds against Kentucky Christian Nov. 20.

STEPHENS ANOTHER CAREER NIGHT

His career was just four games long, but freshman forward center Jake Stephens made a big splash on November 14. The Bunker Hill, W.Va. native poured in a career-high 20 points on 6 of 7 floor shooting and 4 of 4 in three-pointers to help lead VMI to a 78-72 win over USC Upstate at Cameron Hall.

NEW FACES JOIN STAFF

Two new faces joined the VMI coaching and support staff in 2018-19 with Steve Enright being named assistant basketball coach in June and Tom Kiely becoming Director of Basketball Operations in September.

Enright came to VMI from nearby Bridgewater (Va.) College where he served three years on the Eagles coaching staff

and was promoted to associate head coach before the 2016-17 season. Enright previously served on head coach Dan Hurley's staff at Rhode Island where he was the Rams' assistant director of basketball operations. He also coached previously at Pfeiffer University, Mount Ida College, and Endicott College.

Kiely came to VMI from Seton Hall University where he served as a student manager for the men's basketball team for four years and served on the team staff that captured the 2016 Big East Tournament championship.
