## Keydets Conclude Road Swing at Presbyterian

VMI Basketball wraps up its four-game December road swing Wednesday night in Clinton, SC against the Presbyterian College Blue Hose. The Keydets will be searching for their first December win before breaking for the fall semester exam period and it will be VMI's final non-conference road game of the season.

### Last Time Out: Chattanooga 83, VMI 65 - Sunday, Dec. 9

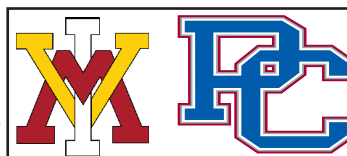
Freshman forward Kevin Easley scored 26 points and added eight rebounds to help lead Chattanooga to an 83-65 win over VMI Sunday at McKenzie Arena in the Southern Conference opener for both teams. The Mocs, who captured their third straight home win, sank 13 3-pointers including seven in the second half to break open the game and end a two-game skid to the Keydets. Chattanooga (5-5, 1-0) placed four in double figures scoring including David Jean-Baptiste (18), Jerry Johnson (17), and Jonathan Scott (11). The Keydets (5-6, 0-1) were led in scoring by guard Bubba Parham with 13 points while guard Garrett Gilkeson chipped in 12 points and eight rebounds and forward Miles Lewis added 12 points and seven rebounds. Forward Sarju Patel tallied 10 points for his fifth double figures scoring game of the season. Chattanooga shot 45.3% from the floor while the Keydets hit at a 38.2% clip. VMI outrebounded the Mocs, 39-38, and got 17 points scoring from its bench. VMI was held to six 3-pointers for the fourth consecutive game and went 6 for 23 from beyond the arc.

### Last Meeting with Presbyterian: VMI 78, Presbyterian 58, Nov. 18, 2017

Junior guard Austin Vereen poured in a career-high 22 points while sophomore Tyler Creammer fell just one rebound shy of a double-double, propelling the VMI Keydets to a 78-58 win over the Presbyterian College Blue Hose in non-conference basketball action November 18, 2017 in Lexington, Va. The contest marked VMI's 2017-18 home opener, and the Keydets never trailed. After the Keydets sprinted out to an 8-0 lead, PC (1-3) used a 10-2 run to tie the game, but Vereen answered with 10 straight points and the Blue Hose got no closer than six the rest of the way. Vereen, who came in 0 for 9 from the field in the first two games of the season, was 7 of 9 from the floor vs. PC and led all scorers with his 22 points. He also equaled a career-high with six rebounds. Creammer bumped his career-high upwards for the third straight game, adding 19 and nine boards, one rebound shy of his first career double-double, while Will Miller chipped in a career-high 12 markers. Presbyterian was led by Montenia Nelson's 13 points.

### SERIES HISTORY – VMI vs. Presbyterian

This will be 15th meeting between the schools that were once conference rivals in the Big South Conference from 2008-2014. It will also be the fourth consecutive season the teams have faced each other in a non-conference setting. VMI leads the over head-to-head 9-5 and has taken two of the last three meetings. VMI's last win in Clinton, SC game on January 5, 2013, 86-77 in the BSC opener for both teams.

### HOLIDAY ROAD

The Keydets will be opening December on a four-game road swing with games at Longwood (Dec. 1), Virginia Tech (Dec. 5), Chattanooga (Dec. 9), and Presbyterian (Dec. 12). VMI does not return home to Cameron Hall until Dec. 21 against North Alabama. All but one of VMI's six games in December are on the road.

### BUBBA STILL ON TOP

Through games of December 9, sophomore guard Bubba Parham continues to lead the SoCon in scoring with a 21.2 PPG average. Parham entered December with four straight 30+ point games, and became the first SoCon player to tally 30 or more points in four straight contests since Steph Curry of Davidson in 2008-09. Not just a scorer, Parham also garnered a career-high nine rebounds with a 30-point outing in VMI's win 87-79 OT win at Stetson. Parham started his blistering four-game scoring stretch when he scored a career-high 35 points and knocked down a school record 10 3-pointers in the 92-82 loss at #10 ranked Kentucky Nov. 18. It was the first time Parham had surpassed the 30+ point plateau in a game in his career and he followed it up two nights later with 33 points against Kentucky Christian at Cameron Hall. Parham, the 2018 SoCon Freshman of the Year as selected by the media, has 12 games of 20+ points in his career.

### GILKESON, PATEL SET SCORING MARKS

VMI guard Garrett Gilkeson and forward Sarju Patel both turned in career numbers in the Dec. 5 game at No. 15 Virginia Tech. Gilkeson set a new career mark in scoring with 21 points while Patel turned in a career-best 13 points.

### ROAD AND OVERTIME LOG

With an 86-79 overtime win at Stetson Nov. 23, VMI ended a two-game skid in extra play and won its first overtime game since February 21, 2015 when the Keydets prevailed 113-111 in 2OT at Western Carolina. The Stetson win was also VMI's first road win of the year and first since a 75-71 win at The Citadel on February 17, 2018.

### LEWIS - A CAREER DAY

Sophomore forward Myles Lewis played a key role in VMI's win at Stetson with a career-high 15 points and career-high nine rebounds. Lewis also tied his career-mark in assists with three vs. the Hatters.

### BOMBS AWAY

The Keydets hit double digits in 3-pointers made in five consecutive games (Nov. 14 through Nov. 23) with 68 treys over that stretch. VMI hit 19 threes at Kentucky Nov. 18 which was the most an opponent had ever made against UK in its long and storied basketball history. VMI also hit 15 threes against Goucher Nov. 11, 10 vs. USC Upstate Nov. 14, 12 vs. Kentucky Christian Nov. 20, and 12 at Stetson Nov. 23. The last time VMI drained 20+ treys in a contest was in a 113-111 win at Western Carolina on February 21, 2015. Over its last four games, however, VMI is just 24 for 104 (23.1%) beyond the arc making just six treys in each outing.

### JOIN THE SCORING PARTY

VMI placed six players in double figures for the second time this season in the 106-80 win over Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 at Cameron Hall. Previously, the Keydets had six reach double figures scoring in the 98-34 win over Goucher Nov. 11 at Cameron Hall. It had been the first time VMI had placed six with 10+ points in a game since February 27, 2016 when VMI outscored The Citadel 111-95.

### HIGH OCTANE

The 106 points scored by the Keydets Nov. 20 vs. Kentucky Christian was first time VMI had hit the century mark in scoring in a game since February 11, 2017 when VMI dispatched The Citadel 101-78.

### GILKESON ON A HIGH

He was known as a dependable defender and rebounder heading into the season, but junior guard Garrett Gilkeson has stepped up his scoring as well and is averaging 10.9 points – second on the team - and shooting 44.1% from 3-point range (15-34). Gilkeson, who leads the team in FT% (82.1%), also tied his career-high with 10 rebounds against Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 and added 15 points for his second career double-double.

### STEADY GREG

VMI sophomore guard Greg Parham has scored in double figures eight games of 11 and is third on the team in scoring with 10.2 PPG. Parham also paces the team in scoring with 37 assists.

### CREAMMER DOUBLES UP

Fresh off a career-high 13 points scoring at Kentucky Nov. 18, junior forward/center Tyler Creammer posted his third career double-double with 12 points and 14 rebounds against Kentucky Christian Nov. 20.

### STEPHENS ANOTHER CAREER NIGHT

His career was just four games long, but freshman forward/center Jake Stephens made a big splash on November 14. The Bunker Hill, W.Va. native poured in a career-high 20 points on 6 of 7 floor shooting and 4 of 4 in three-pointers to

help lead VMI to a 78-72 win over USC Upstate.

### TANG SIGNS IN EARLY PERIOD

Virginia Military Institute head coach Dan Earl announced the signing of 6-5, 185, shooting guard Louis Tang to a national letter-of-intent during the November early signing period.

Tang, who competes in the highly competitive WCAC playing for Saint Mary's Ryken in Leonardtown, Maryland, was tabbed 2017-2018 Honorable Mention All-Conference Selection after averaging 7.0 ppg, 6.0 rpg, and shooting 37% from 3-point range as a junior, playing alongside 2018 Division I signees Wynston

Tabb (Boston College), and Servet Kurnaz (Denver).

Tang led St. Mary's Ryken in scoring (14.6 ppg), rebounding (7.4 rpg), assists (2.6 apg), and steals (2.2 spg) in the prestigious Capitol Hoops Summer League during the 2018 season.

Originally from Kaohsiung, Taiwan, Tang was a member of both the U16 and U17 Taiwanese National Teams, helping the U16 team to a second place finish in FIBA Asia in 2015.

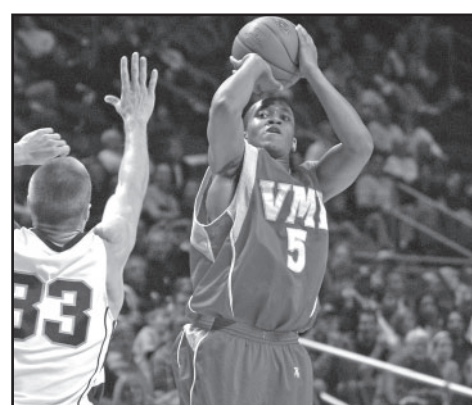
