Keydets Open Three-Game Homestand Saturday vs. UNCG

VMI Basketball enters the new year with a three-game Southern Conference homestand Saturday against UNCG. The Keydets, who have played just one home game since Nov. 27, return to the friendly environs of Cameron Hall where they have posted a 5-1 mark this season.

Last Time Out: Samford 96, VMI 68 - Saturday, Dec. 29

Looking to resume conference play with a win and close the 2018 calendar year on the right note, the VMI basketball team fell short of its goal as host Samford claimed a 96-68 win over the Keydets Saturday afternoon at the Pete Hanna Center in Birmingham, Alabama. The Keydets (6-8, 0-2) were led by sophomore guard Bubba Parham, who put up 24 points on 8-20 shooting including six three-pointers. The tally marked his 14th career game with over 20 points scored these past two seasons. VMI struggled to contend with Samford in the interior as the Bulldogs outscored the Keydets 40-12 in the paint and claimed 46 rebounds to 28 for VMI. Samford also had production from the bench with 44 points coming from reserves while the injury-depleted Keydets registered 19. Samford's hustle paid off with 12 second-chance points and 27 points off VMI turnovers throughout the contest. Three other Keydets logged double digits as Myles Lewis and Jake Stephens both had 11 points while Greg Parham had 10. Samford (11-4, 1-1) was led by 23 points from center Ruben Guerrero.

Last Meeting with the Spartans: UNCG 73, VMI 51 - February 1, 2018

A slow first half start by the VMI basketball team allowed the host UNCG Spartans to build a 41-18 lead at the half and eventual 73-51 victory over the Keydets February 1, 2018 at the Greensboro Coliseum in Greensboro, North Carolina. UNCG proved dominant in several key factors including outscoring the Keydets in the paint, 28-16, scoring 20 points off VMI turnovers and registering 27 points off the bench to VMI's six. The Spartans had four players score in double figures led by 13 from Marvin Smith and 12 from center James Dickey. Vereen led VMI with 14 points on 5-14 shooting from the field and converted four three-pointers. Freshman Bubba Parham contributed 13 points by going 5-7 from the field while sophomore center Tyler Creammer also scored in double digits with 10 points on four buckets.

SERIES HISTORY – VMI vs. UNCG

This will be the 24th meeting between the teams that first met in 1978. UNCG leads the series, 15-8, and has taken the last four meetings. VMI last defeated the Spartans 86-72 on February 11, 2016.

BACK HOME IN JANUARY

The Keydets will take a 5-1 home mark into January as they open up a three-game SoCon homestand against UNCG (Jan. 5), Furman (Jan. 10) and Wofford (Jan. 12). VMI will play four home and four away contests in January.

BUBBA STILL ON TOP

Through games of January 2, sophomore guard Bubba Parham continues to lead the SoCon in scoring with a 22.2 PPG average. Parham entered December with four straight 30+ point games, and became the first SoCon player to tally 30 or more points in four straight contests since Steph Curry of Davidson in 2008-09. Not just a scorer, Parham also garnered a career-high nine rebounds with a 30-point outing in VMI's win 87-79 OT win at Stetson. Parham started his blistering four-game scoring stretch when he scored a career-high 35 points and knocked down a school record 10 3-pointers in the 92-82 loss at #10 ranked Kentucky Nov. 18. It was the first time Parham had surpassed the 30+ point plateau in a game in his career and he followed it up two nights later with 33 points against Kentucky Christian at Cameron Hall. Parham, the 2018 SoCon Freshman of the Year as selected by the media, has 14 games of 20+ points in his career following his 29 point outing vs. North Alabama Dec. 21 and 24 points at Samford December 29.

PATEL, LEWIS SET CAREER MARKS

Sophomore forwards Sarju Patel and Myles Lewis posted career-highs in VMI's 89-68 win over North Alabama Dec. 21. Patel scored a career-high 19 points and hit a career-best four 3-pointers against the Lions. Lewis scored 18 points against UNA for his seventh double-digit scoring game of the year.

GILKESON ON A HIGH

He was known as a dependable defender and rebounder heading into the season, but junior guard Garrett Gilkeson has stepped up his scoring as well and is averaging 10.2 points – second on the team - and shooting 40.9% from 3-point range. Gilkeson, who leads the team in FT% (84.4%), also tied his career-high with 10 rebounds against Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 and added 15 points for his second career double-double.

BOMBS AWAY

VMI regained its 3-point shooting form by knocking in 14 treys against North Alabama Dec. 21 for its first double-digit shooting performance beyond the arc since 12 were drained in the 87-79 win at Stetson Nov. 23. Over its previous five games, VMI was just 33 for 137 (24%) beyond the arc making just six treys in four straight outings. Early in the season, the Keydets hit double digits in 3-pointers made in five consecutive games (Nov. 14 through Nov. 23) with 68 treys over that stretch. VMI hit 19 threes at Kentucky Nov. 18 which was the most an opponent had ever made against UK in its long and storied basketball history. VMI also hit 15 threes against Goucher Nov.11, 10 vs. USC Upstate Nov. 14, 12 vs. Kentucky Christian Nov. 20, and 12 at Stetson Nov. 23. The last time VMI drained 20+ treys in a contest was in a 113-111 win at Western Carolina on February 21, 2015.

VMI is 6-0 when shooting a better 3-point percentage than its opponent and 0-8 when it's the other way...VMI is 4-0 when leading at the half and 5-0 when leading with five minutes left in regulation...the Keydets are 5-0 when outshooting an opponent from the field and 5-1 when outrebounding an opponent...VMI has not committed 20 turnovers in a game this year. Through 13 games last year, VMI had four such games.

ROAD AND OVERTIME LOG

With an 86-79 overtime win at Stetson Nov. 23, VMI ended a two-game skid in extra play and won its first overtime game since February 21, 2015 when the Keydets prevailed 113-111 in 2OT at Western Carolina. The Stetson win was also VMI's first road win of the year and first since a 75-71 win at The Citadel on February 17, 2018.

JOIN THE SCORING PARTY

VMI placed six players in double figures for the second time this season in the 106-80 win over Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 at Cameron Hall. Previously, the Keydets had six reach double figures scoring in the 98-34 win over Goucher Nov. 11 at Cameron Hall. It had been the first time VMI had placed six with 10+ points in a game since February 27, 2016 when VMI outscored The Citadel 111-95.

HIGH OCTANE

The 106 points scored by the Keydets Nov. 20 vs. Kentucky Christian was first time VMI had hit the century mark in scoring in a game since February 11, 2017 when VMI dispatched The Citadel 101-78.

CREAMMER DOUBLES UP

Fresh off a season-high 13 points scoring at Kentucky Nov. 18, junior forward/center Tyler Creammer posted his third career double-double with 12 points and 14 rebounds against Kentucky Christian Nov. 20.

STEPHENS ANOTHER CAREER NIGHT

His career was just four games long, but freshman forward center Jake Stephens made a big splash on November 14. The Bunker Hill, W.Va. native poured in a career-high 20 points on 6 of 7 floor shooting and 4 of 4 in three-pointers to help lead VMI to a 78-72 win over USC Upstate at Cameron Hall. Stephens added three treys in an 11-point outing against Samford Dec. 29 – his first double-digit scoring game since the Upstate game.

TANG SIGNS IN EARLY PERIOD

Virginia Military Institute head coach Dan Earl announced the signing of 6-5, 185, shooting guard Louis Tang to a national letter-of-intent during the November early signing period.

Tang, who competes in the highly competitive WCAC playing for Saint Mary's Ryken in Leonardtown, Maryland, was tabbed 2017-2018 Honorable Mention All-Conference Selection after averaging 7.0 ppg, 6.0 rpg, and shooting 37% from 3-point range as a junior, playing alongside 2018 Division I signees Wynston Tabb (Boston College), and Servet Kurnaz (Denver).

Tang led St. Mary's Ryken in scoring (14.6 ppg), rebounding (7.4 rpg), assists (2.6 apg), and steals (2.2 spg) in the

prestigious Capitol Hoops Summer League during the 2018 season. Originally from Kaohsiung, Taiwan, Tang was a member of both the U16 and U17 Taiwanese National Teams, helping the U16 team to a second place finish in FIBA Asia in 2015.

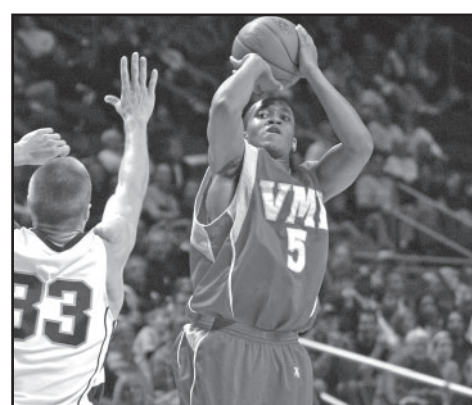
