Keydets Travel to ETSU to face Bucs Thursday

VMI Basketball opens up a stretch of four road games over the next five contests when it travels to Johnson City, Tennessee Thursday night to take on the ETSU Bucs at Freedom Hall. The Keydets will be looking to snap a four-game skid while ETSU will try to extend its seven-game winning streak. It will be the first of two conference meetings between the schools who will also play Feb. 21 in Lexington.

Last Time Out: Wofford 90, VMI 76 - Saturday, Jan. 12

The VMI basketball team gave league-leading Wofford College all it could handle Saturday afternoon, but it wasn't enough as the visiting Terriers defeated the Keydets 90-76 in Southern Conference play. VMI opened the game on a tear, hitting its first six shots en route to opening a 17-6 lead in the first five minutes. Keydet freshman center Jake Stephens earned his first start of the season and responded with two three-pointers and a layup in that span for eight early points. The Terriers chipped away at the deficit and went into halftime ahead 40-38. The Keydets trailed by just three (61-58) at the 11:27 mark after a basket by Greg Parham, but a 20-2 run over the next seven minutes allowed Wofford to open a 81-60 lead and put the contest out of reach. Garrett Gilkeson paced VMI with team-highs of 17 points and seven rebounds, and also added three assists and two steals. Stephens finished with 11 points and five rebounds, his third double-digit scoring game in conference action. Nathan Hoover posted a game-high 25 points and Cameron Jackson had a double-double with 23 points and 10 rebounds.

Last Meeting with the Bucs: ETSU 70, VMI 56 - Feb. 10, 2018

Facing league leader ETSU at home, the VMI basketball team played a strong first half but faltered in the second as the visiting Bucs left Cameron Hall with a 70-56 victory February 10, 2018 in Lexington. The Keydets played a great first half in which they converted 14 shots and shot 42 percent from the field to go into the half trailing by just one point, 34-33. VMI stuck around early in the second half but went cold midway through, hitting a 6-minute patch in which the Keydets missed eight consecutive shots while ETSU extended its lead to 53-43 with nine minutes to play. VMI also played without the services of one of its key players in sophomore guard Keith Smith, who sat out with the flu. VMI was led by sophomore guard Garrett Gilkeson, who went 5-11 from the field and 4-4 from the charity stripe. Freshman Jordan Ratliffe made five buckets including two treys to follow up with 12 points. The Bucs were led by Jalan McCloud's 20 points as he went 7-13 from the field including two treys and 4-4 from the free-throw line.

SERIES HISTORY – VMI vs. ETSU

This will be the 62nd meeting between the teams that first met in 1953. ETSU leads the series, 47-14, and has taken the last six meetings including wins 89-48 (Johnson City, Tenn.) and 70-56 (Lexington, Va.) last year. VMI last defeated the Bucs, 85-79, on January 17, 2015 in Lexington.

STEPHENS STEPS UP

In his first college start, freshman forward Jake Stephens scored 11 points Saturday against Wofford for his third double figures scoring game over the last four contests. Stephens earlier tied a career-high with nine rebounds Jan. 10 against Furman, matching his output of nine rebounds against Goucher Nov. 11. Stephens just missed his first career double-double by one rebound after scoring a team-high 15 points against the Paladins. Stephens is averaging 10.0 points and 5.0 rebounds over his last four conference games.

BUBBA STILL ON TOP

Sophomore guard Bubba Parham continues to lead the SoCon in scoring with a 20.2 PPG average. Earlier in the season, Parham entered December with four straight 30+ point games, and became the first SoCon player to tally 30 or more points in four straight contests since Steph Curry of Davidson in 2008-09. Not just a scorer, Parham also garnered a career-high nine rebounds with a 30-point outing in VMI's win 87-79 OT win at Stetson. Parham started his blistering four-game scoring stretch when he scored a career-high 35 points and knocked down a school record 10 3-pointers in the 92-82 loss at #10 ranked Kentucky Nov. 18. It was the first time Parham had surpassed the 30+ point plateau in a game in his career and he followed it up two nights later with 33 points against Kentucky Christian at Cameron Hall. Parham, the 2018 SoCon Freshman of the Year as selected by the media, has 15 games of 20+ points in his career following his 29 point outing vs. North Alabama Dec. 21 and 24 points at Samford December 29. PATEL, LEWIS SET CAREER MARKS

Sophomore forwards Sarju Patel and Myles Lewis posted career-highs in VMI's 89-68 win over North Alabama Dec. 21. Patel scored a career-high 19 points and hit a career-best four 3-pointers against the Lions. Lewis scored 18 points against UNA for his seventh double-digit scoring game of the year.

GILKESON ON A HIGH

He was known as a dependable defender and rebounder heading into the season, but junior guard Garrett Gilkeson has stepped up his scoring as well and is averaging 10.9 points and 6.2 rebounds – both second on the team - and is shooting 43.1% from 3-point range. Gilkeson, who leads the team in FT% (85.7%) and steals (29), also tied his career-high with 10 rebounds against Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 and added 15 points for his second career double-double.

BOMBS AWAY

VMI regained its 3-point shooting form by knocking in 14 treys against North Alabama Dec. 21 for its first double-digit shooting performance beyond the arc since 12 were drained in the 87-79 win at Stetson Nov. 23. Over its previous five games, VMI was just 33 for 137 (24%) beyond the arc making just six treys in four straight outings. Early in the season, the Keydets hit double digits in 3-pointers made in five consecutive games (Nov. 14 through Nov. 23) with 68 treys over that stretch. VMI hit 19 threes at Kentucky Nov. 18 which was the most an opponent had ever made against UK in its long and storied basketball history. VMI also hit 15 threes against Goucher Nov. 11, 10 vs. USC Upstate Nov. 14, 12 vs. Kentucky Christian Nov. 20, and 12 at Stetson Nov. 23. The last time VMI drained 20+ treys in a contest was in a 113-111 win at Western Carolina on February 21, 2015.

VMI is 6-2 when shooting a better 3-point percentage than its opponent and 0-9 when it's the other way...VMI is 4-1 when leading at the half and 5-0 when leading with five minutes left in regulation...the Keydets are 5-2 when outshooting an opponent from the field ...Saturday's 22 turnovers committed against Wofford was the first time VMI had 20 turnovers in a game this year. Through 16 games last year, VMI had five such games.

ROAD AND OVERTIME LOG

With an 86-79 overtime win at Stetson Nov. 23, VMI ended a two-game skid in extra play and won its first overtime game since February 21, 2015 when the Keydets prevailed 113-111 in 2OT at Western Carolina. The Stetson win was also VMI's first road win of the year and first since a 75-71 win at The Citadel on February 17, 2018.

JOIN THE SCORING PARTY

VMI placed six players in double figures for the second time this season in the 106-80 win over Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 at Cameron Hall. Previously, the Keydets had six reach double figures scoring in the 98-34 win over Goucher Nov. 11 at Cameron Hall. It had been the first time VMI had placed six with 10+ points in a game since February 27, 2016 when VMI outscored The Citadel 111-95.

HIGH OCTANE

The 106 points scored by the Keydets Nov. 20 vs. Kentucky Christian was first time VMI had hit the century mark in scoring in a game since February 11, 2017 when VMI dispatched The Citadel 101-78.

CREAMMER DOUBLES UP

Fresh off a season-high 13 points scoring at Kentucky Nov. 18, junior forward/center Tyler Creammer posted his third career double-double with 12 points and 14 rebounds against Kentucky Christian Nov. 20.

STEPHENS ANOTHER CAREER NIGHT

His career was just four games long, but freshman forward/center Jake Stephens made a big splash on November 14. The Bunker Hill, W.Va. native poured in a career-high 20 points on 6 of 7 floor shooting and 4 of 4 in three-pointers to help lead VMI to a 78-72 win over USC Upstate at Cameron Hall. Stephens added three treys in an 11-point outing against Samford Dec. 29 – his first double-digit scoring game since

the Upstate game. He currently leads the team in blocks with ten.

TANG SIGNS IN EARLY PERIOD

Virginia Military Institute head coach Dan Earl announced the signing of 6-5, 185, shooting guard Louis Tang to a national letter-of-intent during the November early signing period.

Tang, who competes in the highly competitive WCAC playing for Saint Mary's Ryken in Leonardtown, Maryland, was tabbed 2017-2018 Honorable Mention All-Conference Selection after averaging 7.0 ppg, 6.0 rpg, and shooting 37% from 3-point range as a junior, playing alongside 2018 Division I signees Wynston Tabb (Boston College), and Servet Kurnaz (Denver).

Tang led St. Mary's Ryken in scoring

(14.6 ppg), rebounding (7.4 rpg), assists (2.6 apg), and steals (2.2 spg) in the prestigious Capitol Hoops Summer League during the 2018 season. Originally from Kaohsiung, Taiwan, Tang was a member of both the U16 and U17 Taiwanese National Teams, helping the U16 team to a second place finish in FIBA Asia in 2015.

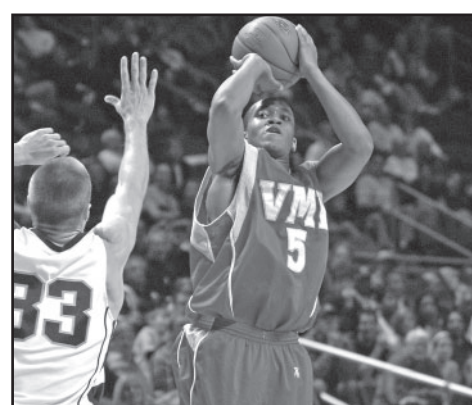
