Keydets Hit Road for Two-Game Swing vs. Mercer, The Citadel

Fresh off its first SoCon win of the season last Saturday, VMI Basketball opens a two-game road swing beginning Thursday night at Mercer at 7:30 p.m. before facing military conference rival The Citadel Saturday afternoon at 1 p.m. in Charleston, S.C. The Keydets will play all three remaining January games away from Cameron Hall, closing out the month Jan. 31 at UNCG.

Last Time Out: VMI 91, Western Carolina 83 - January 19, 2019

Sophomore guard Bubba Parham scored 33 points Saturday afternoon to lead VMI to a 91-83 victory over visiting Western Carolina. The game was tight the entire way - with 18 lead changes. VMI held a 47-44 lead at intermission, but the Catamounts forged a 75-73 advantage after a three-pointer by Kameron Gibson at the 5:21 mark. The Keydets went on an 8-0 run, fueled by two three-point plays from freshman center Jake Stephens, one from beyond the arc and the second on a traditional layup and free throw. Western Carolina trimmed the lead to just two (82-80) with under two minutes to play, but a Parham layup made it a four-point game and VMI iced the contest by sinking seven of eight free throws. Sarju Patel finished with 17 points - 13 in the second half, with four rebounds. Stephens contributed 16 points and two blocked shots, while Myles Lewis netted 13 points. VMI's 18 assists was the second-highest total this season against a Division I foe, and their six turnovers tied its season-low on the year. Western Carolina had three players reach the 20-point mark: Onno Steger (27), Matt Halvorsen (23) and Gibson (20).

Last Meeting with Mercer: Mercer 82, VMI 58- Feb. 15, 2018

Senior guard Demetre Rivers scored 21 points on seven of eight shooting from the floor to help lead Mercer to an 82-58 win over VMI at Hawkins Arena. VMI freshman guard Bubba Parham and led the Keydets with 16 points while junior forward Austin Vereen finished with 14 points and drained four three-point shots and Jordan Ratliffe added 14 points. Sophomore guard Ross Cummings added 14 points and senior guard Jordan Strawberry tallied 10 points and eight assists for the Bears.

Last Meeting with The Citadel: The Citadel 78, VMI 70 - March 2, 2018

The Citadel's Zane Najdawi led all scorers with 16 points as the Bulldogs erased an early first-half deficit and downed VMI 78-70 in the first round of the 2018 Southern Conference Basketball Championship. VMI jumped out to an early lead and held a 29-19 advantage with 5:29 remaining in the first half. From there, the Bulldogs used a 23-7 run that spanned the end of the first half and into the second frame to take the lead for good. The Keydets pulled to game to within three (73-30) with 2:45 to play but would not score the remainder of the game as The Citadel knocked down five free throws to secure the win. Keith Smith paced the Keydets with 15 points.

SERIES HISTORY – VMI vs. Mercer

This will be the 12th meeting between the teams that first met in 2006. Mercer leads the series, 9-2, and has taken the last four meetings including wins 62-56 (Lexington, Va.) and 82-58 (Macon, Ga.) last year. VMI last defeated the Bears, 91-82 on February 25, 2016 in Lexington.

SERIES HISTORY – VMI vs. The Citadel

This will be the 111th meeting between the teams that first met in 1921. The Citadel leads the series 57-53, but the Keydets swept the regular season series last year including wins 88-81 (Lexington, Va.) and 75-71 (Charleston, S.C.) last year. The Citadel prevailed 78-70 in the first round of the SoCon Tournament in Asheville, N.C. on March 2, 2018.

HOT SHOOTING LEADS KEYDETS VS. WCU

VMI turned in its best shooting performance of the year hitting 32 of 57 shots for a season-high 56.1% in the 91-83 win over Western Carolina January 19. The Keydets also dished out 18 assists – the second highest vs. a DI opponent this year.

LEWIS SHINES VS. BUCS

Sophomore forward Miles Lewis turned in a solid performance in the Jan. 19 85-82 loss at ETSU missing his first double-double by a single rebound. Lewis hit 7 of 14 shots from the floor and finished with 17 points, one-point shy of his career-high 18 points. Lewis also tied a career-high in rebounds with nine versus ETSU. He has 11 double figures scoring games on the year after scoring 13 points against Western Carolina on January 19. Lewis has averaged 12.8 points and 5.0 rebounds over his last four games including four straight double-figures scoring games.

WELCOME BACK, WILL

Junior forward Will Miller returned to action on Jan. 17 versus ETSU after missing the previous 14 games with a knee injury. In his first game appearance since Nov. 11, Miller played 12 minutes and scored 2 points. The return was a welcomed sight for a VMI roster that has been depleted by injuries in 2018-19. Miller added another 12 minutes of action and four points vs. Western Carolina January 19.

TURNOVER TURNAROUND

VMI entered the Jan. 17 ETSU game averaging 19.7 turnovers over its previous three games, but committed just 12 turnovers against the Bucs, including four in the second half. VMI followed with just six turnovers vs. Western Carolina January 19, tying the season low mark established against American November 27.

STEPHENS STEPS UP

Sophomore forward Jake Stephens continues to be a consistent scorer for the Keydets in conference play and has tallied double figures in five of the last six games. In his first college start, freshman forward Jake Stephens scored 11 points against Wofford Jan. 12 and followed with 10 points against ETSU. Stephens earlier tied a career-high with nine rebounds Jan. 10 against Furman, matching his output of nine rebounds against Goucher Nov. 11. Stephens just missed his first career double-double by one rebound after scoring a team-high 15 points against the Paladins. Stephens is averaging 11.0 points and 4.7 rebounds over his last six conference games.

BUBBA STILL ON TOP

Sophomore guard Bubba Parham continues to lead the SoCon in scoring with a 20.5 PPG average. Earlier in the season, Parham entered December with four straight 30+ point games, and became the first SoCon player to tally 30 or

more points in four straight contests since Steph Curry of Davidson in 2008-09. Not just a scorer, Parham also garnered a career-high nine rebounds with a 30-point outing in VMI's win 87-79 OT win at Stetson. Parham started his blistering four-game scoring stretch when he scored a career-high 35 points and knocked down a school record 10 3-pointers in the 92-82 loss at #10 ranked Kentucky Nov. 18. It was the first time Parham had surpassed the 30+ point plateau in a game in his career and he followed it up two nights later with 33 points against Kentucky Christian at Cameron Hall. Parham, the 2018 SoCon Freshman of the Year as selected by the media, has 17 games of 20+ points in his career following his 25-point outing at ETSU Jan. 17 and 33-point game Saturday vs. Western Carolina.

PATEL, LEWIS SET CAREER MARKS

Sophomore forwards Sarju Patel and Myles Lewis posted career-highs in VMI's 89-68 win over North Alabama Dec. 21. Patel scored a career-high 19 points and hit a career-best four 3-pointers against the Lions. Lewis scored 18 points against UNA for his seventh double-digit scoring game of the year.

GILKESON ON A HIGH

He was known as a dependable defender and rebounder heading into the season, but junior guard Garrett Gilkeson has stepped up his scoring as well and is averaging 10.4 points and 6.2 rebounds – both second on the team - and is shooting 42.6% from 3-point range. Gilkeson, who leads the team in FT% (86.4%) and steals (34), also tied his career-high with 10 rebounds against Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 and added 15 points for his second career double-double.

BOMBS AWAY

VMI produced its 11th double figures 3-point game Saturday vs. Western Carolina and has 35 treys over its last three games. Earlier in the season, the Keydets hit double digits in 3-pointers made in five consecutive games (Nov. 14 through Nov. 23) with 68 treys over that stretch. VMI hit 19 threes at Kentucky Nov. 18 which was the most an opponent had ever made against UK in its long and storied basketball history. VMI also hit 15 threes against Goucher Nov. 11, 10 vs. USC Upstate Nov. 14, 12 vs. Kentucky Christian Nov. 20, and 12 at Stetson Nov. 23. The last time VMI drained 20+ treys in a contest was in a 113-111 win at Western Carolina on February 21, 2015.

THIS AND THAT

VMI is 7-3 when shooting a better 3-point percentage than its opponent and 0-9 when it's the other way...VMI is 5-1 when leading at the half and 6-0 when leading with five minutes left in regulation...the Keydets are 6-3 when outshooting an opponent from the field ...The Keydets have had just two games this season decided by five points or less...VMI is 3-0 when scoring 90 points or more.

ROAD AND OVERTIME LOG

With an 86-79 overtime win at Stetson Nov. 23, VMI ended a two-game skid in extra play and won its first overtime game since February 21, 2015 when the Keydets prevailed 113-111 in 2OT at Western Carolina. The Stetson win was also VMI's first road win of the year and first since a 75-71 win at The Citadel on February 17, 2018.

JOIN THE SCORING PARTY

VMI placed six players in double figures for the second time this season in the 106-80 win over Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 at Cameron Hall. Previously, the Keydets had six reach double figures scoring in the 98-34 win over Goucher Nov.11 at Cameron Hall. It had been the first time VMI had placed six with 10+ points in a game since February 27, 2016 when VMI outscored The Citadel 111-95.

HIGH OCTANE

The 106 points scored by the Keydets Nov. 20 vs. Kentucky Christian was first time VMI had hit the century mark in scoring in a game since February 11, 2017 when VMI dispatched The Citadel 101-78.

STEPHENS ANOTHER CAREER NIGHT

His career was just four games long, but freshman forward.center Jake Stephens made a big splash on November 14. The Bunker Hill, W.Va. native poured in a career-high 20 points on 6 of 7 floor shooting and 4 of 4 in three-pointers to help lead VMI to a 78-72 win over USC Upstate at Cameron Hall. Stephens added three treys in an 11-point outing against Samford Dec. 29 – his first double-digit scoring game since the Upstate game. He currently leads the team in blocks with 14.

TANG SIGNS IN EARLY PERIOD

Virginia Military Institute head coach Dan Earl announced the signing of 6-5, 185, shooting guard Louis Tang to a national letter-of-intent during the November early signing period.

Tang, who competes in the highly competitive WCAC playing for Saint Mary's Ryken in Leonardtown, Maryland, was tabbed 2017-2018 Honorable Mention All-Conference Selection after averaging 7.0 ppg, 6.0 rpg, and shooting 37% from 3-point range as a junior, playing alongside 2018 Division I signees Wynston Tabb (Boston College), and Servet Kurnaz (Denver).

Tang led St. Mary's Ryken in scoring (14.6 ppg), rebounding (7.4 rpg), assists (2.6 apg), and steals (2.2 spg) in the prestigious Capitol Hoops Summer League during the 2018 season. Originally from Kaohsiung, Taiwan, Tang was a member of both the U16 and U17 Taiwanese National Teams, helping the U16 team to a second place finish in FIBA Asia in 2015.

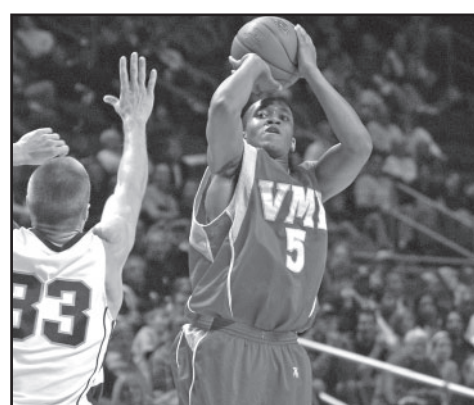
