Keydets Face Mercer Thursday to Begin Two-Game Homestand

VMI closes out the regular season with a two-game Southern Conference homestand beginning with Thursday's matchup with Mercer at Cameron Hall. The Keydets, fresh off a season sweep of Western Carolina following last Saturday's 83-78 win in Cullowhee, will be looking to square the season series against Mercer after dropping the first game against the Bears in Macon in January. Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN3.

Last Time Out: VMI 83, Western Carolina 78 - Saturday, Feb. 23, 2019


Sophomore guard Bubba Parham scored a career-high 38 points to help lead VMI past Western Carolina, 83-78, Saturday night in Southern Conference basketball action at the Ramsey Center. Parham hit 13 of 26 shots from the floor including four 3-point shots on the night and in the process became the 41st player in VMI basketball history to hit the career 1,000 point threshold. The Snellville, Ga. native now has 1,016 points in his Keydet career. Sophomore guard/forward Myles Lewis produced his first career-double double with 15 points and a career-high 12 rebounds and junior Garrett Gilkeson added 15 points as the Keydets swept the season series from the Catamounts. It was the first win for the Keydets this season after trailing at the half as VMI shot 52% from the floor after intermission. WCU led 43-39 at the break following an opening half that saw nine lead changes between the conference rivals. VMI held as much as a nine-point advantage.

Last Meeting with the Bears: Mercer 88, VMI 68 (Jan. 24, 2019)

Junior guard Ross Cummings hit six 3-pointers and scored 24 points to lead Mercer past VMI, 88-68, in Southern Conference action at Hawkins Arena in Macon, Georgia. The Bears, winners of two straight, used a strong first half to build a lead that the Keydets found difficult to overcome after halftime. VMI was led by junior guard Garrett Gilkeson who scored 15 points and added nine rebounds. Sophomore guard Bubba Parham added 17 points, but labored through a 2-for-11 shooting night from beyond the arc. Mercer shot 56.1% from the floor and was 10-of-19 from 3-point range while dishing out 19 assists led by sophomore guard Marcus Cohen who had seven dishes. The Keydets, hampered by turnovers in the first half, dug themselves a hole that proved insurmountable as Mercer built a 52-31 intermission lead. The Keydets committed nine turnovers in the opening stanza which led to 19 Bears points. VMI fought back after halftime trimming the deficit to 14 points (54-40) on a Jake Stephens 3-pointer at the 17:47 mark, but could come no closer despite nine second half points by forward Sarju Patel who started the second half. The Keydets outrebounded the Bears, 34-32, but were outscored in the paint by a 40-26 count. Mercer also received double-digit scoring efforts from redshirt junior guard Ethan Stair (18 points, 7 rebounds) and guard Jaylen Stowe with 17 points.

SERIES HISTORY – VMI vs. Mercer

This will be the 13th meeting between the teams that first met in 2006. Mercer leads the series, 10-2, and has taken the last five meetings including wins 62-56 (Lexington, Va.) and 82-58 (Macon, Ga.) last year and 88-68 in Macon on January 24. VMI last defeated the Bears, 91-82 on February 25, 2016 in Lexington.

BUBBA BOUNCES BACK

Sophomore guard Bubba Parham is on top of the SoCon scoring list (20.6) after a career-high 38 points at Western Carolina Saturday. The game followed a career-low two points vs. ETSU Feb. 21 and made Parham the 41st player in VMI history to score 1,000 career points. One week earlier at Wofford, Parham had a 30-point night at Wofford February 14 for his sixth 30+ outing this year. Earlier in the season, Parham entered December with four straight 30+ point games, and became the first SoCon player to tally 30 or more points in four straight contests since Steph Curry of Davidson in 2008-09. Not just a scorer, Parham also garnered a career-high nine rebounds with a 30-point outing in VMI's win 87-79 OT win at Stetson November. 23 and tied his career-best in assists with seven against Samford Feb. 9. Parham started his blistering four-game November scoring stretch when he scored a career-high 35 points and knocked down a school record 10 3-pointers in the 92-82 loss at #10 ranked Kentucky Nov. 18. It was the first time Parham had surpassed the 30+ point plateau in a game in his career and he followed it up two nights later with 33 points against Kentucky Christian at Cameron Hall. Parham, the 2018 SoCon Freshman of the Year as selected by the media, has seven career 30+ games (all this season) and 21 games of 20+ points in his career including 14 this year.

LEWIS DOUBLES UP

Sophomore guard/forward Miles Lewis continued his strong February surge and posted his first career-double-double in the Feb. 23 win at Western Carolina with 15 points and a career-high 12 rebounds. One game earlier, Lewis turned in a career scoring night against ETSU February 21 when he tallied a career high 27 points on 9-of-18 shooting from the field against the Bucs and grabbed eight rebounds. Against Wofford on February 14, Lewis scored a then career-high 22 points against the Terriers. Lewis also had a solid performance in the Jan. 19 85-82 loss at ETSU missing his first double-double by a single rebound. Lewis hit 7 of 14 shots from the floor and finished with 17 points and also tied and then career-high in rebounds with nine versus ETSU. Second on the team in scoring (10.8 PPG), Lewis has 18 double figures scoring games on the year and is averaging 16.5 points and 4.8 rebounds over his last four games.

KEYDETS SHOOT SEASON BEST

VMI shot a season-high 57.6% against SoCon leading Wofford February 14 thanks in part to a 64.7% performance in the second half when the Keydets converted 22 of 34 shots from the floor.

GILKESON ON A HIGH

Junior guard Garrett Gilkeson continues to perform at a high level and grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds to go along with 13 points and a career-best seven assists vs. Samford February 9 at Cameron Hall. The afternoon was his fourth career double-double. Known as a dependable defender and rebounder heading into the season, Gilkeson has stepped up his scoring as well and is averaging 10.5 points, third on the team – and leads the team in rebounding (6.2), steals (45) and free throw shooting percentage 80.3% although he does not have enough attempts to qualify among the league leaders. Gilkeson is also shooting 44.8% from 3-point range and has three made treys in eight games this year. Gilkeson pulled down 11 rebounds to go with 11 points at The Citadel Jan. 26 for his third career

double-double and previously had 10 rebounds against Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 and added 15 points. For the eight games in January, Gilkeson scored in double figures in six contests and averaged a steady 12.3 points, 7.5 rebounds, and shot 51.7% from the 3-point line.

PATEL SETTLING IN AS STARTER

VMI sophomore guard Sarju Patel, who has eight starts on the season, produced his first double figures scoring game as a starter with 14 points against Chattanooga Feb. 7 and has since produced three such games after 12 points vs. ETSU Feb. 21. On the year, Patel has 12 double figures scoring games. VMI employed its third starting lineup combo of the year when it inserted Patel at guard against The Citadel January 26.

STEPHENS TOP FROSH

Sophomore forward Jake Stephens continues to provide scoring punch for the Keydets in conference play and has tallied double figures in seven of the last 15 games. In his first college start, freshman forward Jake Stephens scored 11 points against Wofford Jan. 12 and followed with 10 points against ETSU. Stephens earlier tied a career-high with nine rebounds Jan. 10 against Furman, matching his output of nine rebounds against Goucher Nov. 11. Stephens just missed his first career double-double by one rebound after scoring a team-high 15 points against the Paladins. He added 15 points with four 3-pointers vs. Samford Feb. 9 – tying his career-best in made 3-point shots.

HOT SHOOTING LEADS KEYDETS VS. WCU

VMI turned in one of its best shooting performance of the year hitting 32 of 57 shots for a then season-high 56.1% in the 91-83 win over Western Carolina January 19. The Keydets also dished out 18 assists – the second highest vs. a DI opponent this year.

BOMBS AWAY

VMI produced its 15th double figures three-point shooting game after hitting 10 treys at Western Carolina February 23. Earlier in the season, the Keydets hit double digits in 3-pointers made in five consecutive games (Nov. 14 through Nov. 23) with 68 treys over that stretch. VMI hit 19 threes at Kentucky Nov. 18 which was the most an opponent had ever made against UK in its long and storied basketball history. VMI also hit 15 threes against Goucher Nov. 11, 10 vs. USC Upstate Nov. 14, 12 vs. Kentucky Christian Nov. 20, and 12 at Stetson Nov. 23. The last time VMI drained 20+ treys in a contest was in a 113-111 win at Western Carolina on February 21, 2015.

THIS AND THAT

Saturday's win at Western Carolina was VMI's first when trailing at the half this season... VMI is 8-5 when shooting a better 3-point percentage than its opponent and 0-15 when it's the other way... VMI is 5-2 when leading at the half and 7-3 when leading with five minutes left in regulation... The Keydets have had just five games this season decided by five points or less and the win at Western Carolina Feb. 23 was VMI's first win in such contests... VMI is 3-0 when scoring 90 points or more.

ROAD AND OVERTIME LOG

With an 86-79 overtime win at Stetson Nov. 23, VMI ended a two-game skid in extra play and won its first overtime game since February 21, 2015 when the Keydets prevailed 113-111 in 2OT at Western Carolina. The Stetson win was also VMI's first road win of the year and first since a 75-71 win at The Citadel on February 17, 2018.

JOIN THE SCORING PARTY

VMI placed six players in double figures for the second time this season in the 106-80 win over Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 at Cameron Hall. Previously, the Keydets had six reach double figures scoring in the 98-34 win over Goucher Nov. 11 at Cameron Hall. It had been the first time VMI had placed six with 10+ points in a game since February 27, 2016 when VMI outscored The Citadel 111-95.

HIGH OCTANE

The 106 points scored by the Keydets Nov. 20 vs. Kentucky Christian was first time VMI had hit the century mark in scoring in a game since February 11, 2017 when VMI dispatched The Citadel 101-78.

TANG SIGNS IN EARLY PERIOD

Virginia Military Institute head coach Dan Earl announced the signing of 6-5, 185, shooting guard Louis Tang to a national letter-of-intent during the November early signing period.

Tang, who competes in the highly competitive WCAC playing for Saint Mary's Ryken in Leonardtown, Maryland, was tabbed 2017-2018 Honorable Mention All-Conference Selection after averaging 7.0 ppg, 6.0 rpg, and shooting 37% from 3-point range as a junior.

Tang led St. Mary's Ryken in scoring (14.6 ppg), rebounding (7.4 rpg), assists (2.6 apg), and steals (2.2 spg) in the prestigious Capitol Hoops Summer League during the 2018 season. Originally from Kaohsiung, Taiwan, Tang was a member of both the U16 and U17 Taiwanese National Teams, helping the U16 team to a second place finish in FIBA Asia in 2015.

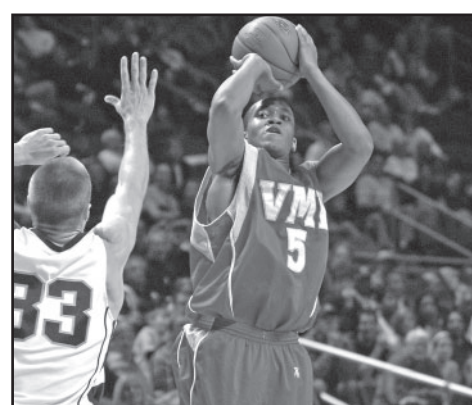
